(2) Only TSPGA members can participate.

(3) This match starts after the Shotgun match at approximately 1:30 PM.

(4) Tuesday After Work Match: May 30th, August 29th, & October 31st are 5th Sunday matches with a 9:30 AM start. All other matches are held on Tuesday evenings starting at 6:30 PM.

(5) The Glock match is scheduled for the 1st weekend in May. The Work party will be cancelled for this weekend. The range will be closed on the afternoon of Friday, April 30th for the Glock match setup. Volunteers needed.

(6) The annual DPC meeting for all club members is scheduled for Sunday December 5th at 2:00pm.

<b>Precision Matches</b>	<b>Air Pistol Training</b>	<b>B. Brinson</b>	Provides instruction, training, leadership, and volunteer opportunities to youth and adults interested in Olympic-style shooting sports with an emphasis on promoting high ideals, moral character, the development of personal potential and good sportsmanship through individual and group coaching.
	<b>Airgun PTO</b>	<b>B. Brinson</b>	DPC hosts quarterly Preliminary Try Out (PTO) matches. The matches are USA Shooting-approved.
	<b>Silhouette Match</b>	<b>K. Markwardt</b>	Metallic silhouette shooting is a group of target shooting disciplines that involves shooting at metal cutouts representing game animals at varying distances. Metallic silhouette shooting at DPC is done with approved caliber pistols and .22 rim fire rifles both in standard configuration and cowboy lever action. The targets used are rams, turkeys, pigs, and chickens, which are cut to different scales and set at certain distances from the shooter depending on the specific discipline. Ranges vary from 40m to 100m. Setup and practice begins at 7:30 and the match begins at 9am.
	<b>JOPC Match</b>	<b>B. Brinson</b>	Junior Olympic Pistol Championship is the State qualifier for the Junior Olympics held in Colorado Springs at the Olympic Training Center every spring. The match, in air pistol and sport pistol .22 only at the DPC, is for juniors (under 21) only.
	<b>TSRA State Match</b>	<b>B. Brinson</b>	The TSRA State Championship is International (Olympic) air pistol.
	<b>Bullseye 2700</b>	<b>B. Chapman</b>	Bullseye matches follow the National Rifle Association's Conventional Pistol Competition rules, which consists of firing slow, timed, and rapid fire. This is done at 25 and 50 yards outdoors.
	<b>Bullseye 2700 Regional</b>	<b>B. Chapman</b>	NRA registered 2700 conventional outdoor pistol match
	<b>Bullseye 1800</b>	<b>B. Chapman</b>	NRA 1800 conventional outdoor pistol match
	<b>Bullseye-Provost Guard Match</b>	<b>J. Gainer</b>	Open to TSPGA Shrine members only. 25 yard 900 match.
<b>Action Matches</b>	<b>Personal Protection Match</b>	<b>T. Clore</b>	The Personal Protection Match is aimed toward maintaining and enhancing self-defense skills by performing shooting drills geared toward improving reaction times, developing defensive techniques, and improving accuracy. Stages are set up to simulate potential real-life situations requiring target recognition, shooting order, utilization of cover, shooting while moving, and close-quarter techniques.
	<b>Shotgun Match</b>	<b>C. Smith</b>	Tactical Shotgun matches usually consist of 4-5 stages (60-75 rounds required), primarily utilizing steel targets shot with birdshot. Tactical aspects are addressed, such as, but not limited to: shoot/don't shoot and "hostage" targets, use of cover and concealment, reloading and weak side shooting techniques and at least one stage as a "plate rack" speed shooting oriented. Most matches will require some limited use of slug ammo (5 rounds or less).
	<b>22LR Action Match</b>	<b>R. Mathews</b>	The 22 action match uses a semi-automatic 22LR, magazine fed rifle, capable of speed reloading. Most competitors use an AR-15-type rifle with a 22LR adapter kit, a dedicated 22LR upper or similar rifle. Ruger 10/22's are also common. Dot sights and magazine clamps are permitted.
	<b>Tuesday After Work</b>	<b>S. Speer</b>	This matches tests your accuracy, speed of target acquisition, ability to shoot from multiple positions, and overall gun handling ability, using rectangular or round metal targets at 10 to 25 yards. Each match consists of a minimum of three separate courses of fire and will require between 90-100 rounds of ammunition; multiple strings of fire, may require movement, may require reloads, and may utilize props as vision barriers or to vary start positions. 9mm to 45 ACP pistols with holsters.
	<b>Tactical Match (RWG)</b>	<b>Myers/Ellul</b>	Real World Gun matches, in the "IDSA style", test your skills with your carry firearm in your carry holster. This tactical match mimics "the real world" so you're prepared for actual defensive situations. Optic sights, dots, compensators, and extended magazines (must fit flush with the firearm) are not allowed. Only 9mm caliber and larger, subject to DPC's approved caliber list, can be used in this match. Law Enforcement Officers may use their duty equipment.
<b>Steel Matches</b>	<b>Metal Mania</b>	<b>R. Suchan</b>	Metal Mania matches test your speed and accuracy with a handgun, using metal targets at 10 to 25 yards. At each of five stages, competitors will attempt to hit or knock down all of the plates in the shortest amount of time. Hitting the specially designated stop plate ends the run, regardless of how many other plates have been hit. The slowest time on each stage is dropped, and competitors are ranked within their class.
	<b>Real Steel</b>	<b>R. Mathews</b>	Real Steel matches test your speed and accuracy with a handgun, using metal targets at 10 to 25 yards. At each of five stages, competitors will attempt to hit or knock down all of the plates in the shortest amount of time. There are differences between the Metal Mania match using start and stop plates. The slowest time on each stage is dropped, and competitors are ranked within their class.

	<b>Work Party</b>	<b>R. Suchan</b>	All volunteer club members come to cut grass, eradicate weeds, clear brush, and do projects to keep the club property in good condition. We need your participation to keep club maintenance cost down.
<b>Special Events</b>	<b>4-H Practice-Airgun</b>	<b>D. Smith</b>	Airgun practice for 4-H club youth members.
	<b>Women's Shooting Group</b>	<b>C. Smith</b>	The Dallas Pistol Club's Women's Shooting Group has been established to provide a comfortable atmosphere for women who are interested in shooting. All ages and experience levels are welcome. You do not need to be a member of the club to attend, nor do you need to have any prior exposure to shooting, just an interest. Trained Range Officers (ROs) will walk you step by step through loading ammunition, aiming, and firing, with a special understanding of a woman's needs (because we're women, too). Event dates and topics will be posted on the club web site.
	<b>Glock Match</b>	<b>D. Smith</b>	This two day event brings participants from all over Texas and beyond. There are three courses with 3 or 4 stages consisting of 4 to 7 paper or steel targets. Prizes include cash, merchandise, and certificates for Glock pistols.
	<b>NRA Basic Pistol Class</b>	<b>B. Wessel</b>	The Dallas Pistol Club now offers the NRA Basic Pistol course for beginning shooters who want to learn the fundamentals of handling and shooting a pistol safely. The course also covers other important aspects of owning a handgun, such as selecting the proper ammunition and cleaning the pistol. The classes are taught by NRA certified instructors and are recommended for all members of the family.
	<b>CHL Classes (New &amp; Renewal)</b>	<b>G. Ruth</b>	The Dallas Pistol Club now offers a Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS) approved course that is required for those who wish to apply for a Concealed Handgun License. The course includes mandated classroom instruction, document notarization, passport-style photographs, assistance in completing the required paperwork, and live-fire qualification on the DPC range.
	<b>Annual Club Meeting-Clubhouse</b>	<b>Members</b>	Any DPC member is welcome to hear and participate in the ongoing issues and club plans discussed and executed by the DPC directors and club officers. DPC Director election results are announced and new club plans are discussed.
